RULE BOOK

1. PARTICIPATION AND ELIGIBILITY

The prestigious 6 th Das National Gesetz Fest debate competition, 2026 (Malayalam) will be hosted by the Kerala Law Academy Law College, on the 6th of March 2026. This competition will be open to all the colleges affiliated with recognized universities. Each team may comprise of only 2 participants with both members exclusively representing the same institution. A College/University may send a maximum of two teams. The number of participating teams shall be limited to 20 teams with preference given to teams based on the order of their registration. It is mandatory requirement for all the participants to carry their respective college id card.

2. REGISTRATION

The teams will have to register themselves by filing the Google form <https://forms.gle/WJsWECTouDzKVkfU7> kindly complete and submit the registration form. The registration fee for the event is Rs.300/- (for a team).

3. COMPETITION PROCEDURES

- * Both the speakers from each team will have to present for the motion and against the motion.
- * The competition shall consist of 3 rounds:
- * Preliminary Round, Semi-final Round and Final Round. For the Preliminary Round and Semi-final Round, each speaker shall be allowed to speak for 1 minute and each team will get a total of 90 seconds for rebuttal.
- * For the Final Round, each team shall be allowed to speak for 3 minutes and the rebuttal will be of 150 seconds.
- * As per the Draw of Lots, the team who speaks (for the motion) shall individually contest with the team who speaks; (against the motion).
- * The cumulative marks of both the speakers of one team shall decide the position of the team and its further promotion to the Final Round.
- * At the end of their presentation each speaker may face questions from the judges.

RULE BOOK

* The participants will be judged based on the criteria that may include the construction, content, delivery as well as diction of their presentation

5. ANONYMITY OF PARTICIPANTS

All the participants must refrain from disclosing the identity of themselves and their institution at any time and in any manner, during their participation in the competition. The disclosure of identity may result in the disqualification of the teams from the competition.

6. GENERAL RULES

* Use of foul or obscene language will lead to disqualification.

* Participants can use any source of information during preparatory period. No book, document or electronic gadget shall be allowed to the participant while speaking.

* On all appeals and disputes, the participants may approach the principal and the decision of the principal shall be final.

* The organizers reserve the right to alter or change the rules and regulation or the procedure of the competition without prior intimation.

* In matters of dispute, the decision of the organizing committee shall be final


